

Section I: Request

The College of Nursing is requesting an emphasis name change from Teaching Nursing to Nursing Education within the Masters program at the College of Nursing. The name change proposal was taken to the MS/DNP standing committee in the College of Nursing on October 26, 2012. Rational was provided for the emphasis name change. The vote passed unanimously.

Section II: Need

The program title *Teaching Nursing* has been confusing to both students and faculty. *Nursing Education* is more a more commonly used phrase within the discipline of nursing and is better understood by students and faculty. In the phrase *Teaching Nursing*, the word nursing is meant to signify the profession, however, the word 'nursing' is also frequently used as a verb, leading to confusion. A program titled Nursing Education is less confusing.

Section III: Institutional Impact

No activities will be impacted. No instructional activities will be impacted. No institutional changes will be made. No structural changes will be made. The Nursing Education emphasis will be reflected on the student's transcripts beginning with the cohort graduating in 2013.
